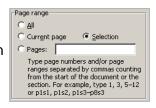
# **Printing Options**

Printing only a portion of a text

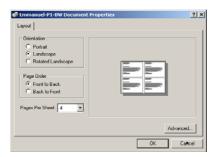
Select (highlight) the text you wish to print,

click print, and click
"Selection" in the

"Selection" in the Page Range section of the Print Window.

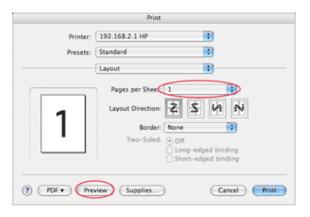


#### Printing Multiple Pages Per Sheet



When using Windows, click the Properties... button in the Print Dialogue to chose mutiple pages per sheet.

In Mac OS X, select **Copies & Pages** in the **Print** dialog box. In the dropdown menu, select **Layout.** Select your desired pages per sheet and you can **Preview** to verify before printing.



# Photocopying

There are two copy machines in the Emmanuel College Library. They are located in the **Reference Area**, and on the **2**<sup>nd</sup> **floor**.

Cost is 15¢ per page for a black and white copy. In addition, the machine in the Reference Area can scan to USB without charge or do colour copies for 50¢ a page. Only the 2nd floor copier accepts change. They both accept T-card.

## Putting Money on your T-Card

The **Cash to Card** machine, located across from the **Loan Services Desk**, allows you to put money on your T-card.

The machine will take bills and \$1 & \$2 coins; the **Loan Services Desk** can provide change if required.

Do not remove your card unless the machine indicates that it is safe to do so.

## Laptop Computers Loans

Laptop computers equipped with text editing programs and internet access are available for in-library use on a 6 hour loan. Ask at the **Loan Services Desk** for loans and additional information.

To borrow a laptop, students must have a valid T-Card. Information cannot be saved on laptops, so it is suggested students bring their own USB drive.

# Guide to Printing Including wireless printing





# Printing at the Library

Printing is available from all computers at the Emmanuel College Library.

Black&White printing is available in the library for 15¢/page. The printer is located by the **Public Computers.** 

Wireless printing is available for laptops. We do not provide colour printing or printing on special paper or transparencies.

#### To print

- Select the print option in the program you wish to print from. (In most cases, you click the print icon, or select File > Print).
- 2. The Pharos Print Job Details window will now be displayed.

Enter a name that will allow you to recognize your print job and follow the on screen directions.





#### Note:

When printing a PDF from an Internet browser, be sure to click the print icon from within the PDF window, and NOT the print icon from the browser menu.

# Wireless Printing

Wireless printing allows laptops connected to the U of T campus wireless network (UTORcwn) to print to selected campus printers, including the **Emmanuel Library printer** and the **E.J. Pratt first floor printer**.

#### Wireless Printing with Mac OS X

To print wirelessly from a Mac laptop, you must add the details of the printer to your printer settings.

- From the Apple Menu, open Systems Preferences option. Click the Print & Fax icon.
- Click the '+' to add a new printer and then select "IP Printer".
- Enter the Address, Queue, and Name fields as shown below.
- Click the **Add** button to complete the configuration. The printer is now available for wireless printing from your OS X computer.



**Note:** When printing from your Mac you will <u>not</u> be prompted to *name* your print job.

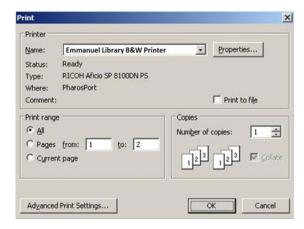
Instead, the title of the document will be passed to the Print Release Station as the name of your job.

#### Wireless Printing with Windows

To print wirelessly with Windows XP & Vista, you must install a print driver provided by University of Toronto.

- In your browser, go to: printhere.utoronto.ca/packages.asp and select the Emmanuel Printer
- 2. Save the file, then run the application.
- Follow the onscreen instructions to complete the installation.

After installation **Emmanuel Library B&W Printer** will appear as a printer option in your standard print window, as seen below.



When a document is sent to the **Emmanuel Printer** the Pharos Print Screen will be displayed, asking you to give an identifying name to your print job. Afterwards there will be a prompt as to the location of the printer.
